It has been an exceptionally busy and difficult year for all of us at CCSC and your help is very much appreciated. I would particularly like to thank the other members of the committee for their help in my first few months as chair of the club. Their continued support makes a tough job that little bit easier.

I would also like to thank all our professional and volunteer coaches for their continued dedication towards developing and enhancing the performance standard of our club and the individual swimmers and giving every swimmer the chance to realise their potential.

It is also important to thank each parent and family member of CCSC swimmers for your support. Swimming is an extremely tough sport and the swimmers could not progress as far as they do without the support from home.

The start of the year was marred by the sad and untimely passing of Keith Bewley and I know that all of us connected with the club have felt his loss keenly. It has been extremely heartening to see everyone involved with CCSC pull together and support each other while dealing with the numerous factors that have arisen because of his sudden death. Coaches covered many extra sessions while dealing with their own personal grief, swimmers supported each other, parents supported the swimmers and volunteers organised the memorial gala and fundraising activities that supplemented Keith's fund so that his legacy and his memory continues to be at the forefront of our minds. I know Keith's family take great comfort from this. Thanks to all involved in this endeavour.

Finally, thanks must go to Parkwood Leisure for their continued support of this club.

REFLECTION ON 2017 SO FAR

The club has again enjoyed a hugely successful year. After the dizzy heights of Rio 2016, 2017 has brought multiple international and national successes. I'm sure that our Head Coach, Graham Wardell will provide the detail behind these successes but our athletes have been winning medals and representing their country in a myriad of competitions and settings from the European Youth Olympics, the US Open, the Commonwealth Youth Games and much more.

Also, this year, we not only made the Arena 'A' final for the second year running but placed third, which was a fantastic result. Our supporters received the accolade of 'Best Supporters' at the arena final for the second year running also, along with three individual swimmer prizes.

We also saw our Head Coach, Assistant Head Coach, Dale Frantzeskou and newly appointed Age Group Coach, David Cocks, be placed on national coaching teams therefore facilitating the experience gained there to be brought back into the club for the benefit of the swimmers.

All of this was achieved while the club and the coaching team was under a great deal of strain, with the loss of Keith leaving the coaching team under staffing pressures. We start a new season buoyed up by the appointment of Ben Reid (Assistant Coach-Fast Track and Competitive), Thomas Edwards (Assistant Coach-Academy) and Ellie Booth (Assistant Coach) and I'm sure you will all join me in wishing them well in their new roles.

Summertime brought some exciting racing but also celebration in the form of our summer social event. The fundraising and social team brought a festival vibe to CCSC and we were blessed some good weather to make the event even more enjoyable. It is tantamount to the hard work of all involved in this team that this event along with others and the fundraising efforts such as successful grant bids, raffles, cake sales and bag packing that have been so successful, continue to be so well supported. Well done to all involved.

We held our annual club championships at the weekend and it was pleasing to see many first-time volunteers wearing either white or red appearing alongside swimmers who were competing for the first time. The club simply cannot function without this volunteer time so selflessly given, so thanks to all that donated their time and continue to donate their time for the club and the swimmers. Thanks also to our trophy team of Andrea Skene and Leah Lloyd who seem to work on club championship trophy matters

throughout the year and manage to ensure that the swimmers who have won trophies receive them in a timely fashion.

As parents, we invest a lot of time into this sport for our children but the investment of your time volunteering really does make the experience more enjoyable for all, as you get to know other parents in other squads and long days at galas really do pass more quickly if you are helping at the event or supporting the club in other roles outside of competitions. If you have been thinking about helping but are not sure what is involved then please do not hesitate to contact our volunteer co-ordinator, Claire Millar, or any member of the committee.

Our treasurer will present his report later but Ian King continues to ensure that the finances of the club run smoothly. He has been ably assisted in this task by Andrea Davies who has prepared the accounts that have been circulated. You will notice that the club is currently running a large reserve but Mr King has allocated this money to offset the potential sting of any pool hire price rises that may ensue if a new centre operator was to take over the running of CIP. The management committee are developing a reserves policy to ensure that the management of reserves is appropriate and prudent and maximises the benefit to the club and swimmers and where suitable, is re-invested back into the club.

At the time of writing this report, the tender process for the new contract of running the facility has still not been decided which means that some of the necessary building maintenance issues are unable to be progressed. One of these, and the one that has the biggest impact on the running of our meets, is the timing system and scoreboard. The running of galas continues to be affected by this but we are working continually with Parkwood, behind the scenes, to continue to deliver local events at our main home pool. As soon as we have progress information on this then we will let the membership know.

The club website is an important asset to the club and has undergone a recent upgrade. I would like to thank Mr Stephen Jones for his continued management of this valuable resource.

LOOKING FORWARD

We are at the start of a new season, with new coaching appointments, new volunteers, an excellent officials' programme (run by Mr Jim McCulloch), more team managers than ever before and an exciting programme of racing ahead of us. I am looking forward to what the next year may bring and hope that the club can continue to support the hopes and dreams of our swimmers as they chase selection for the Commonwealth Games through to participating in their first gala.

I am grateful to be a part of the CCSC family and thank you for your continued support of the club.

5. Treasurer's Report (Ian King) on Accounts for the year ended 31st March 2017

Treasurer Report – Accounts for y/e 31 March 2017

The accounts show a higher than expected surplus for the accounting year. That is primarily due to an increase in the profits from home meets and the saving of some coaching fees following the unexpected loss of Keith Bewley.

It is acknowledged that the club does have a large amount of funds on hand. The Club Management Committee has for the past few years made a conscious decision to put funds aside to offset an increase in pool hire costs, which are likely in the near future.

The surplus would hopefully ensure that there is no dramatic increase in squad fees as a result of increased pool costs.

Pool Hire Costs -

The position is complicated with regard to the hire of Cardiff International Pool. The Council originally granted a 25-year lease to Orion Leisure, which included a 2-year build period.

Following the completion, Orion granted a 10-year operating lease to Parkwood Leisure, which expires in January 2018.

Orion has effectively washed its hands of the matter and Parkwood Leisure is now negotiating direct with Cardiff City Council. It was hoped that the negotiations would have been completed by now so the Club would have a clear idea of where we are moving forward. Unfortunately the talks are ongoing.

At present the club benefits from a 46% reduction on the hire cost of CIP. If that discount was no longer available, on current hire charges, it would mean an increase of £7.2K per month i.e. £86.5K per annum.

Cardiff City Council pools are now operated by GLL. I am pleased to advise that to date the club is still benefiting from the substantial 68% reduction in pool hire costs.

I suspect that at some stage GLL will look to reduce the amount of discount.

It has to be borne in mind that if no discount is forthcoming then pool hire costs for Council pools would increase by £54K per annum. Even a 50% deduction would still mean a doubling of our current Council pool hire costs.

Members Fees and Subscriptions -

During the year the club maintained the monthly squad fees. The last increase in monthly subscriptions was on 1st September 2014, although the fees for a couple of squads have slightly altered due to a change in pool hours.

At the last AGM I gave an assurance that squad fees would not increase for at least a year following the April 2017 introduction of the annual membership fee. That remains the same and it is hoped it will continue, but the uncertainty over the Parkwood position and pool hire costs remains a great concern.

Whilst the surplus funds are put aside in anticipation of increased pool costs, the Club Management Committee is actively looking at ways of giving something back to the membership e.g. increase in club sponsorship of training camps, possible equipment purchase, etc

Head Coach's Report

2017 has been another great year in and out of the pool for the City of Cardiff Swimming Club. Since the last AGM we have outstanding achievements by swimmers in the club – detailed at the foot of this document.

The highlight of the year was having three swimmers – Ioan Evans, Rebecca Sutton and Hannah Sloan - and Coach Dale Frantzeskou selected to represent Wales at the Commonwealth Youth Games, as well as having Kyle Booth selected to represent Great Britain at the European Youth Olympic Festival. It is fantastic to see our young swimmers following our development pathway and achieving such critical levels of success.

We also had a very successful year at the domestic meets, recording our best ever finish at the Welsh Summer Meet, as well as one of our most successful years at the British Summer Meet. Congratulations to all swimmers who worked so hard over the last 12 months to achieve these successes outlined above. It is a credit to you and your family that you are able to balance your academic/work and sporting workload and consistently perform at this level.

Additionally, I am delighted to report that we placed third in the 'A' final of the National Arena League final in 2017. Xavier Mohammed and Chloe Tutton won the top Male and Female awards, while Rebecca De Torres won the award for the most improved female swimmer in the 13-14 years age group. Once again, this is our highest finish for a number of years and we showed good strength in depth across the age groups. Well done to our fantastic supporters who cheered the team on every step of the way and were also rewarded with the "top supporters" award.

My thanks go, as always, to all of the coaches who have worked so hard over the year to ensure that the standards of quality instruction are driven upwards year on year, while maintaining the fun too. It has been a tough year following on from the death of Keith Bewley in January as we lost not only a hard working coach of outstanding calibre, but also a very dear friend. The coaching staff has gone above and beyond the call of duty to ensure that we were able to keep things together.

It is great that we have been able to recruit some additional coaches to ensure that we are fully staffed going into the 2017/18 season and I would like to take this opportunity to welcome Ellie Booth, Tom Edwards and Andrew Horsfall-Turner to our coaching team. I know they have been making their presence felt on deck already! We did lose another member of staff last season. Adam Crompton decided that he was unable to continue coaching alongside studying for the final year of his degree, so has had to step down. I would like to thank Adam for all of his hard work while at our club and to wish him all the very best for the future. I am very lucky to be surrounded by coaches with experience, enthusiasm and drive whose love of the sport creates such a positive environment in the club.

There is no doubt we could not be as successful as we are in the water without great governance by the committee, and I would like to thank all of the committee members and co-opted members who have helped to run the club this year. It has been a year where we have truly come together as a club, with lots of fun activities and fund raising events taking place over the season. We have also done a great job once again in running our home meets with great success. These are pivotal to our future because without the revenue they generate, we would not be able to run the programme. I am indebted to all of the meet organisers and volunteers who steadfastly do their jobs, often under very trying conditions, for the benefit of all of the swimmers in the club.

This year we are building on our overseas trips, running two training camps for the age group and youth/senior swimmers in the High Performance and Elite programmes as well as the annual Stuttgart trip which encompasses the Competitive programme swimmers as well. These trips not only have great sporting merit, but also are a great experience for the young swimmers to develop their resilience, self-management and coping skills. Many thanks to those of you who give up your time to act as team managers and chaperones to allow these trips to run.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to personally thank every parent, grandparent, family member and friend who has gone out of their way to support our young swimmers in achieving their sporting dreams. Your support in this partnership is priceless!

Here's to better again this season – Dare to dream, and to dream big!
